Day 1

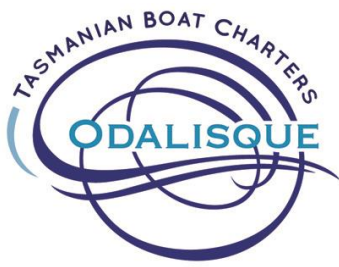
The location and time of the start of your charter is as negotiated with Tasmanian Boat Charters. We are very flexible with time and pick up locations.

Hobart pick up locations include Elizabeth St Pier, Kings Pier Marina, the Queens Domain and with prior arrangement many other public or private jetties within the Hobart area, including Bellerive, Wrest Point Casino, Mona and local yacht clubs & marinas.

Pick-up locations outside of Hobart, including on Bruny Island or any location on the East Coast, are available too. Please enquire with your preferred location.

Our East Coast Charters include:

- *Accommodation aboard Odalisque*
The *Odalisque* provides luxury and functionality to ensure an outstanding experience. With three double cabins and single bunk alternatives, serviced by three bathrooms, the *Odalisque* is able to sleep 10 guests in comfort. This capacity ensures that the sleeping configurations remain private and comfortable.
- *Tailored itinerary*
Itineraries can be tailored to our guests' preference on charter duration & destinations, and of course, to your own personal interests, whether they be hiking, beachcombing, bird spotting, sightseeing from the jet boat or simply relaxing aboard the *Odalisque*.
- *Skipper*
Skipper Pieter van der Woude, who is also the owner of the business, will be your host on the majority of our charters. His lifetime of experience and passion for Tasmanian waters and marine life makes him the perfect skipper for guests wanting to explore Tasmania's coastline.
- *Chef*
Guest chefs provide top-notch, modern Tasmanian fare. We borrow our chefs from some of the best restaurants in Hobart, and you can expect meals as inspiring as the landscapes in which we dine.
- *All meals*
Breakfast, lunch, dinner and all snacks are provided for you by our onboard chef. Please let us know of any dietary requirements in advance.
- *Beverages*
A selection of fine Tasmanian wines, local boutique beer (including tap beer!) & spirits are available on board. A limited number of alcoholic beverages is included daily with your package. Additional alcoholic beverages can be purchased from our onboard bar. Non-alcoholic drinks are freely available.
- *Wet weather gear & other handy items*

Additional charges

There are some activities or items during your trip which will incur additional charges. These include:

- Emergency evacuation or emergency search charges.
- Additional beer, wine and spirits purchased from our onboard bar.
- Specialised activities, such as diving and kayaking.

Any additional charges incurred while on a charter can be paid for at the end of your charter.

Weather

The dynamic weather is one of the many attractions of Tasmania's unique coastline. Daytime summer temperatures can range from 10°C to 35°C and at least one day of rain or drizzle is to be expected. Evening temperatures regularly drop below 10°C. Take a look out our 'What to pack' section for suggestions as to what you might need to be comfortable in any weather.

Cost

Charter for the entire vessel starts from \$6,600 per day, plus \$150 per person per day.

Deposit & Final Payment

A 10% non-refundable deposit is required to confirm your booking. No bookings will be guaranteed until a deposit has been received and availability on dates requested has been confirmed by us. Final balance of payment is due 30 days prior to departure.

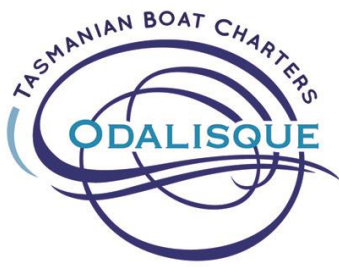
If a booking is made 30 days or less from the date of charter, full payment is due at the time of the booking.

Payment is available by Bank Transfer or Credit Card. We accept Visa, Mastercard & Amex. There is a credit card surcharge of 2% for all credit card payments for our charters.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation by Guest

- If your booking is cancelled less than 30 days prior to departure Tasmanian Boat Charters shall retain the full charter fee paid.
- If a booking is cancelled more than 30 days prior to departure the deposit paid is non-refundable but transferable to another charter date within 18 months of original dates.
- The date of cancellation is the date Tasmanian Boat Charters receives written notice of cancellation.
- Cancellation also applies if guests fail to show at the arranged venue for departure. Tasmanian Boat Charters will retain the full charter fee paid.

- No refund will be paid if guests choose, for whatever reason, to leave the charter after it has commenced.

Cancellation by Tasmanian Boat Charters

Tasmanian Boat Charters reserves the right to cancel any trip due to weather conditions, insufficient numbers or other circumstances outside of its control. In such a case, guests will be given a choice of

- Transferring payments towards another trip date
- Receiving a full refund

Safety & Medications

If you are taking any medications please be sure to let Tasmanian Boat Charters staff know and to include an extra supply. It is also important that you let us know if you have any pre-existing medical conditions or injuries. Our supplies of non-prescription medications are limited. If this is a concern, feel free to bring your own.

Our skipper and all our guides hold either a wilderness or marine first aid qualification. We carry an extensive first aid kit, satellite communication, location beacon, marine radio and flare kits in case of emergencies.

Power & Phones

Mobile phone coverage is limited in some areas we may be travelling. Please check with Tasmanian Boat Charters' staff to find out more about the extent of coverage you can expect on your charter.

Where there is no reception, we see this as a great opportunity for complete escape from the hustle and bustle of day-to-day life. However, we do understand that in some special situations you may need some communication with the outside world. In these circumstances, it is possible for guests to send and receive text messages and to receive calls only via the Tasmanian Boat Charters' phone. Please feel free to ask the skipper to use the phone if necessary.

Power is available on board to charge up any devices.

Disability access

There is no disability access aboard the *Odalisque*.

What to pack

Some essential items. Please note, this is not an exhaustive list

- Lightweight hiking boots (note: some tracks are muddy, rutted and overgrown)
- Dry & clean footwear for wearing aboard *Odalisque* (something that's comfortable and easy to get on & off eg. Sneakers or 'boat shoes')
- Lightweight raincoat
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Warm polar fleece or down jacket
- Personal medications
